- d. Historic District re-branding: set-up for future expansion (possible cultural alliance); one website to be set-up with separate pages for each organization, one Facebook page
- e. Orphanage Museum Update: meeting w/Chris Busse and Jenna Tuma, Master Plan being worked on by the City (do not know where the OAC or Orphanage Museum fits in this plan), potential for moving Orphanage Museum out of the main building (unique space) currently it is not a very welcoming place, meeting with Mark Walbran (city attorney); comment from Anne relationship with the City of Owatonna started in '92, never a contract, since the merger with SCHS, contract* is a requirement *Reference copy of amended contract in board meeting packet*
- f. OHS Museum met with Superintendent on site; potential for merger (passport), favors working with another new entity, leave collection at school, keeps constant connection/access with students; offer to help with exhibit at the new high school do not know what future exhibits will look like, keep storage space at old high school, more discussion forthcoming on this topic
- g. Grant for moveable walls in main exhibit area (retracting submission to Owatonna Foundation)
